

## Game: ACROSS EUROPE WITH ERASMUS+

### Content:

- 1 board
- 100 cards with questions
- 40 picture cards
- 5 figurines/ tokens
- 1 dice

### Game instructions and rules:

On the board, there is a map of Europe and there are 100 spaces numbered 1 to 100. The start and the finish are in the same larger space. On the board, there are two rectangular boxes to put down the blue and the red piles of cards.

Some spaces are colored blue and red or marked by a symbol. There are:

- 30 red spaces,
- 10 blue spaces,
- 10 boxes with flags of 5 countries: Germany, Poland, Greece, Turkey and Slovenia ; 2 each
- 10 boxes with smiley symbols
- 5 spaces with EU flags.

The game can be played by 5 players. The goal of the game is to arrive at the finish first.

Players place their figurines on the START space. The first player rolls the dice and the number tells him how many spaces he can move. When he comes to a colored space, he must complete a task. When a player comes to a symbol space, a reward or a punishment follows.

Landing on the:

- Red space: The player who is behind you raises the red card from the red pile and reads a question. For the correct answer, you move one space forward. For an incorrect answer, you move one space backwards.
- Blue space: The player who is behind you raises the blue card from the blue pile and reads a question: In which country can we find this sight?  
For the correct answer, the player moves two spaces forwards. For an incorrect response, he moves two spaces backwards.
- Space with flags of the countries: Move forwards again according to the same number on the dice thrown previously.
- Space with an EU flag: Throw the dice again and move forwards.
- Space with the ☹ symbol: Miss a turn.

If another player arrives at the same space, you share it. The winner of the game is the player who comes to the FINISH first.
